

Reflections on World War II @ San José Libraries: Sharing your WWII images with San José Community members

San José Public Library and San José State University Library invites members of the community to share their personal photos reflecting World War II memories and experiences using our photo sharing website group, [Reflections on WWII @ San José Libraries](#). Images can be uploaded from home allowing personal photos to be shared with other community members.

How do I upload my photos?

1. Become a Member

You must become a member of Flickr in order to upload and share your personal photos. Membership is FREE. Go to www.flickr.com and choose “Create Your Account” to begin the process. *One technical note, do not use the browser Mozilla Firefox, as all features on Flickr are not supported when using it.*

2. Upload and Tag Your Photos

After you have become a member, you may upload your photos to your account. Uploading your photos can be done using a variety of methods. Go to the Flickr “[How to upload](#)” page to learn how to upload your photos. Remember to “tag” your photos. Tagging a photo means you are labeling it. This where you’ll want to note dates, place names, personal names and commentary. Also, when asked “Who can see these photos,” be sure to click “anyone” so that other community members can view them.

3. Join the Group and Add Your Photos

Next go to the San José Libraries group page “[Reflections of WWII @ San Jose Libraries](#)” and join our group. Once you are a member of the group you can add your photos to it. Return to your page (click on “You” near the upper right-hand corner of the page) to select the photos you would like to add, click on “send to group,” and then choose “Reflections on WWII @ San José Libraries group.” You will receive a confirmation that the image has been added to the group page. Repeat the process for each photo you would like to add.
