- *What do you like about this picture?*
- *What don't you like about this picture?*
- *How do you think the artist made this picture?*



Read other books by the same illustrator and see how the pictures are the same or different.

Re-Reading Favorites

Why is it important to reread the same stories?

- It helps your child gain confidence.
- It encourages your child to "read" with you.

You can make re-reading fun by:

- Asking your child to join in as you read.
- Acting out parts of the story.
